My dear parishioner,

Happy Holy Week!

Let us enter into it already triumphant because we are walking with Jesus.


It is the holiest of weeks of the year. Catholics and all other Christians will solemnly celebrate in commemoration the Passion and death of Jesus. It is this time when we, as a Church, remembers what Salvation and redemption is all about. That is when the son of man suffered and died in obedience to the will of the loving Father to save all of us from eternal death. Here is the greatest love of all. It happened during Holy Week at the "Easter Triduum": Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.

We begin this celebration with Palm Sunday. All of us should take part in this meaningful liturgy. We take with us palm branches to Mass. Remembering that when Jesus entered Jerusalem, he was greeted by the people waving palm branches. In ancient times, it was a gesture of victory. The People thought Jesus was going to lead a revolution against the Romans. It was something bigger than the Romans that Jesus was saving the people from. It was not also the way the expected. The palms of victory for the people now became a symbol of entry into Christ's death. A few days later Jesus entered into His death. But, as we all know, His death was a victory over Evil. Eternal condemnation was destroyed. What looked like a failure became a powerful sign of Triumph. The palm you hold in your hands reminds you that you will walk with Jesus into the way, His way of defeating the enemy.

Please come to the "Easter Triduum" I mean attend to all the liturgies during this Holy Week. The solemn drama and symbols in our celebrations are at the same time the vessels of grace to strengthen us in our faith journey. On to the victory of Easter.



Here's One Positive Encouragement

Written by a fellow parishioner

While contemplating the idea for this HOPE, I began thinking about the unstable economic, political, and social events occurring in the world today. In my mind the question arose as to why they are happening? I believe God would answer that evil has taken over and infiltrated large parts of our society. I feel after more than two thousand years that we, supposed followers of Christ, have allowed this potential humanitarian crisis occur. I recalled a pamphlet written by Thomas Paine in December of 1776 titled "The Crisis", a portion of which follows: "These are the times that try men's souls. The summer soldier and the sunshine patriot will, in this crisis, shrink from the service of their country; but he that stands by it now, deserves the love and thanks of men and women. Tyranny like hell is not easily conquered yet we have this consolation with us, that the harder the conflict, the more glorious the triumph. What we obtain too cheap we esteem too lightly: it is dearness only that gives everything its value. Heaven knows how to put a proper price upon its goods, and it will be strange indeed if so celestial an article as freedom should not be highly rated." What meaning does this paragraph have for our HOPE today and our circumstances? How can we help to correct these circumstances? Let us change some words and see if we can live our lives by these changes. These are the times that try men's souls. The summer Catholic and the Christian patriot, in this crisis of such evil, shrink from the service of their God; but he that stands by his God now, deserves the love and thanks of man and women. Earthly evil like hell, is not easily conquered; yet we have this consolation with us, that the harder the conflict of standing for our religious beliefs, the more glorious the triumph. What we obtain too cheap, our inherited religion, some may esteem too lightly: it is dearness, love of God, and our religion only, that gives everything its value. Heaven knows how to put a proper price upon its goods of love and truth, and it would be strange indeed if so celestial an article as freedom from evil should be a decision in our personal religious life and not be highly rated.







