


A Special Year to Bear Witness to Family Love

Here's One Positive Encouragement

Imagine you are a follower of Jesus. It has been 3 days since Jesus was crucified. That morning, some of Jesus' believers reported that Jesus' body was missing from the tomb. When they arrived at the tomb, the ground shook and the men who were guarding the tomb ran away, afraid. An Angel spoke to the women who had arrived saying that Jesus was no longer in the tomb. "He is risen just as he said, go and inform his disciples". How would you have reacted to the news? Remember you did not know then what you know now about Jesus. You as a follower, loved Jesus and were still trying to reason why such a good person had to die in such a cruel way. What type of speculations started to run rampant? Where was his body, who and where was the so-called Angel who said Jesus had risen just as he said he would? Would you have believed he had risen? Probably if you were a positive person genuinely believing in his teachings, had no ego, was not afraid of telling others what you believed, not being afraid of being ridiculed or ostracized, you would believe he was alive and had risen. If you were a negative-thinking person, used to following leaders and not thinking for yourself and your leaders were the ones who put Jesus to death, you probably could not and would not have believed that Jesus rose from the dead but believed that his disciples stole the body and bribed the guards.

Why am I referring to the Resurrection today? To remind us that most of the news and information we receive today is secondhand, just as the information the women were spreading after returning from Jesus's tomb. By spreading this information to townspeople and the disciples this would have been secondhand information spread by them. I do not think any of us can think of a more confusing time then what we are living in now. Nothing is normal, words are having different meanings, things that are happening do not make sense anymore, most of us are or have been suffering in different areas and feel that the decisions being made by others are creating this havoc in our lives and we are paying the price. We always have HOPE by looking at all situations for their positive aspects, they are always there. Remember, we are here on earth in preparation for heaven and nothing can stop us if we have HOPE.
