A Letter from Father Sheldon

My dear Parish Family,

In our time today, it has become more challenging for many to believe that Jesus is still in our midst. Especially by the fact that his appearance is even more different now than what the the apostles saw. He is not in his earthly human form. He is not even in his resurrected form. But he is present with us now in the Sacraments. Only by the humble faith with the grace of the Holy Spirit, that we will see and experience his presence.

After the appearances of the risen Lord, the disciples had to continue to face more challenges. But then they were not afraid anymore. For us also, it is not going to be easy but He assured us we will share in his resurrection. One thing we must remember here is that though Jesus, in his resurrected body can pass through walls, but he retained his scars. He even allowed Thomas to touch them. The marks of his death is a necessary remembrance to celebrate fully his resurrection. Thus we acclaim at Mass. "We proclaim your death oh Lord and profess your resurrection".

This Second Sunday of Easter is also called Divine Mercy Sunday. This was proclaimed by Saint John Paul II. It is on this Sunday that we look at the resurrection as an act of God's loving mercy. And his sacramental presence in our midst is Mercy at work. We may have our fears. We may have our doubts. Going to the sacraments will always help us find peace and courage. Through them, we are able to touch Him, to know, to feel, and to experience His saving grace and mercy.

May the Risen Lord continue to shine his light upon us. May our Heavenly Mother, the Virgin Mary, show us hope.




