

The Sacrament of Marriage

GUIDELINES FOR GODPARENTS/SPONSORS

Have you been asked to be a GODPARENT? Have you been asked to SPONSOR someone ready to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, or for an adult in the RCIA program?

It is an honor and a privilege to be asked. You are seen as someone that a family, child, teenager, or adult looks up to as living a strong, Christian Catholic faith. You model that behavior in the way that you live your life.

To receive a sponsorship form signed and sealed by the Pastor, please keep the following in mind:

- I am age 16 or older.
- I am registered in the parish.
- If married, the marriage is recognized by the Catholic Church.
- I attend Mass on a regular basis.
- I contribute to the support of the Church, as best I can. (Attendance is taken by the envelopes in the collection basket).
- I receive Sacraments according to the Laws of the Church, and I fulfill the requirements listed above.

The Church takes very seriously the role of being a sponsor. Choosing a sponsor would be based on the person's dedication to the faith and regular practice thereof. **Please do not ask us to sign if you do not meet criteria above.**





Here's One Positive Encouragement

New Beginnings, New Beginnings, are there really New Beginnings, or are they the old beginnings morphing into the next evolution that God has for our body and especially our soul? Two thousand years ago, Mary Magdalene started out at the beginning of a new day to minister to the body of a friend and rabbi, someone she and others believed to be the prophet that was going to free them from earthly tyranny. They believed Jesus was here on earth as the Son of the Almighty God who had granted Him the gift of the Holy Spirit after his baptism to perform events that could only be deemed miracles. Jesus had the characteristics of the one whom John the Baptist and the other prophets of old, said the Redeemer would have. Yet, the New Beginning the people had expected was lying dead in a tomb. Mary ran back to summon Peter and the others saying that the body was stolen. They all ran back to the tomb. Peter entered and discovered the two burial cloths, one of which was folded. Some could not accept that he had died, some were hoping he was not dead, others were worrying how would they continue to spread the word without their leader. None realized at the time that this was truly a New Beginning for them and humanity. They did not realize they were to spread the words that Jesus preached and were to continue His teachings through their new ministry. Was this truly a New Beginning for humanity, Jews, and non-Jews? Was this the religion of Moses, that of one true God with Ten Commandments as a way of living and serving God on earth so to share his glory in heaven? Did God morph his commandments using Jesus's teachings to obtain a truly New Beginning and understanding for men? To be one with God in heaven we must experience what the one He called His son Jesus experienced? We not only need to follow God's commandments, but we also need to follow the examples and legacy that Jesus left us. Sometimes sacrifice and hardship must be endured to profess God's commandments. HOPEFULLY, this springtime of Easter may be the New Beginning of our chosen ministry to others.




