

The Sacrament of Marriage

Holy Matrimony is the covenant a man and woman make to one another and to God to work as partners for the rest of their lives. The woman and man marry one another before a witness of the Church and representatives of the community.

You must be actively registered for 6 months to schedule a marriage preparation meeting at least 1 year in advance of the wedding date. Please do not book venue before choosing date with the parish. Please register as a parishioner

Why is it so important to register with a parish? Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Some people think they automatically are registered just by attending Mass regularly in a particular parish but it requires a form to be submitted to the parish office with copies of

sacrament records. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration is also necessary for certain benefits and administrative purposes such as, scheduling sacraments, obtaining a sponsor or godparent eligibility form if requirements are met, a qualification letter from the pastor and receiving a year end donation tax statement. Weekly collection envelopes are used to track attendance at Mass. Registration in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish. A Letter from Father Sheldon

Dear Parish Family,

This weekend, the Gospel story of the disciples on the road Emmaus invites us to always approach the Eucharist when hope seems lost. It is there that we recognize Jesus' presence in this life. He has never left us.

The two disciple were walking away from Jerusalem. They lost their hopes and aspirations because of the death of Jesus. They were downcast. On their journey a stranger joined their conversation. This stranger slowly made them understand how the scriptures talk about the Savior. They started to become interested in the stranger that they invited him for supper. Finally it was there that they realized it was their Lord, after he broke the bread in their presence.

Our life is a journey. But maybe like the two disciples, at some point we feel down and out. We think Jesus has left us. Easter reminds us that Jesus is walking with us closer than ever. Because he want us to walk on. And as we continue our journey he wants us to remember him in the Eucharist, the bread that we break and share at Mass. IN the Eucharist we see everything that happened and what it promises. There he continues to be present, to open our eyes of faith so that we will see him walking with us. And if we walk with him he can lead us to a new direction- The road that leads to our eternal joys.

Next Week, our Parish will celebrate in prayerful joy as our young children will receive Holy Communion for the first time. They have come to know Jesus present in the Eucharist. He is no longer a stranger to them but a friend to nourish them as they grow in their journey of faith.

Last weekend, I made the announcement at all Masses except, the 11:00 AM Mass, that I asked Bishop O'Connell to grant me a much needed time-off for a few months. The kind bishop has given me his permission. He is sending Fr. Marcin Kania to replace me and continue taking care of you. He will arrive as I leave on May 1st, 2023. While I am on this journey, Please continue to pray for me as I do for you. Thank you!
