A Letter from Father Marcin

Dear Parish Family,

Happy Easter! This Second Sunday of Easter concludes the eight-day celebration of Christ's resurrection, which is also referred to as Octave of Easter. Each day during the octave of Easter is like Easter Sunday. Although the world moves on, we Catholics continue to celebrate, to highlight the significance of the Easter holiday, but also to extend the joy that flows from this great event of our Faith. That is why I have started this message, by wishing you a Happy Easter. The Second Sunday of Easter is also designated as Divine Mercy Sunday. We may ask why pope St. John Paul II established this celebration on Second Sunday of Easter? The simple answer is because Christ himself made a request to St. Faustina Kowalska that the Holy Father should establish Divine Mercy Sunday on the second Sunday of Easter. Therefore pope St. John Paul II fulfilled Christ's request. We may ask, why Jesus requested that? Because Jesus wanted to remind us of his great mercy toward us, which the people were forgetting about or ignoring and as a result of not coming to Christ and seeking his mercy many souls were being lost to hell. Jesus wanted to remind us of his great mercy that he has obtained for us in his great passion on the cross. Jesus did not want the sinners to keep themselves away from his mercy, because of the gilt of their sins or fear of punishment. He wanted to call them back to him to receive his grace of mercy, so that souls of those people who are weight down with sin may come with confidence to Christ and out of the bounty of his loving heart they may experience the tender embrace of God's love and healing grace in their souls. Jesus told St. Faustina that he is offering this last chance to the world, a time of mercy and if however, people refuse to come to receive his mercy then they would have to face the hand of Justice of God. Jesus also asked St. Faustina, a polish nun, that a painting of her vision of Christ would be created so that those who venerate that image may obtain many graces for themselves and for others, especially harden sinners. Jesus asked her to pray at 3pm the Chaplet of Divine Mercy to beg God for mercy upon the world. Jesus called 3pm, the Mercy Hour, because at that time he died on the cross for sins of the world. Jesus also promised that those who pray this prayer of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy with those who are dying, that the soul of the dying would receive consolation and hope to not loose trust in God's mercy. This Sunday at 3pm we will honor this Second Sunday, the Sunday of Divine Mercy with service at St. Jerome Church. If you are able to join us then please do so, so that before the Blessed Sacrament, the Eucharist, the sacrament of God's love, we may pray together to the Heavenly Father to bestow mercy upon our world, so that sinners may be converted, those in despair or hopelessness may turn to God with trust in his loving mercy, that those who live in fear may receive a grace of confidence and trust in God, who will not abandon them even in the most desperate moment. We will also pray for the peace in the world, which can truly happen when people return to God. May the Joy of Risen Christ continue to strengthen your heart because His mercy endures forever.

The Sacrament of Marriage

Holy Matrimony is the covenant a man and woman make to one another and to God to work as partners for the rest of their lives. The woman and man marry one another before a witness of the Church and representatives of the community. Are you prepared, as you follow the path of Marriage, to love and honor each other for as long as you both shall live? You must be actively registered for 6 months to schedule a marriage preparation meeting at least 1 year in advance of the wedding date. Please do not book venue before choosing date with the parish. Why is it so important to register with a parish? Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Some people think they automatically are registered just by attending Mass regularly in a particular parish but it requires a form to be submitted to the parish office with copies of sacrament records. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration is also necessary for certain benefits and administrative purposes such as, scheduling sacraments, obtaining a sponsor or godparent eligibility form if requirements are met, a qualification letter from the pastor and receiving a year end donation tax statement. Weekly collection envelopes are used to track attendance at Mass. Registration in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish. GUIDELINES FOR GODPARENTS/SPONSORS

Have you been asked to be a GODPARENT? Have you been asked to SPONSOR someone ready to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, or for an adult in the RCIA program?

It is an honor and a privilege to be asked. You are seen as someone that a family, child, teenager, or adult looks up to as living a strong, Christian Catholic faith. You model that behavior in the way that you live your life.

To receive a sponsorship form signed and sealed by the Pastor, please keep the following in mind:

- I am age 16 or older.
- I am actively registered in the parish for at least 6 months.
- If married, the marriage is recognized by the Catholic Church.
- I attend Mass on a regular basis.
- I contribute to the support of the Church, as best I can. (Attendance is taken by the envelopes in the collection basket, even if empty).
- I receive Sacraments according to the Laws of the Church, and I fulfill the requirements listed above.

The Church takes very seriously the role of being a sponsor. Choosing a sponsor would be based on the person's dedication to the faith and regular practice thereof. Please do not ask us to sign if you do not meet criteria above.
