# A Letter from Father Marcin

Dear Parish Family,

The month of August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The physical heart of Mary is venerated because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love, especially for her divine Son and it is the place from which her virtues and inner life flow. Because Mary's heart has such an excellence in love and virtue, that our devotion to her heart should inspire us to imitate her love and virtue in our hearts. Although our love for Christ would never measure to that of Mary's heart, still it is a worthy ideal to strive for, to love Christ as much as we can following in Mary's footsteps. Mary's heart loves Christ so completely that we believe the hearts of Jesus and Mary are completely united. Mary's love for Christ in heart surpasses any creature in heaven or on earth. Because Mary's heart has such a great love for Jesus, that her heart suffers with the heart of Jesus, when God is not loved, but greatly offended, by our sins. Mary's heart suffers when the many unfortunate souls are lost for ever to hell, for which her son has suffered so much in his passion and on the cross. Mary's loving heart suffers when people's hearts are indifferent and apathetic to the call of God to repentance and refuse to believe in her Son. Nothing pleases Mary more than when we turn to God with faith and trust, and we seek to please God in everything and in humility of heart. Nothing alleviates Mary's suffering heart than when we seek to love God with our whole heart. It consoles her heart when we are willing to bear with love our sufferings and love God through our suffering.

The way that we can make up to God for the offenses that Mary's heart suffers for all the blasphemies against her person is to practice the devotion to the five first Saturdays. To practice this devotion we are called to pray the rosary with the intention of reparation for the blasphemies against Mary's Immaculate Heart, we need to receive confession and holy communion with the same intention, we need to meditate for 15 minutes on one of the mysteries of Holy Rosary, and offer a prayer to the Immaculate Heart of Mary with the intention of making reparations for all the sins committed against Mary.

This month on August 8th we remember St. Dominic who was a founder of Dominican Order of Preachers. St. Dominic had a great devotion to Our Blessed Mother. It is traditionally believed that Mary appeared to him and gave him the rosary as a devotional prayer through which his order and others who will pray the rosary, would receive many graces and Mary's protection. St. Dominic entrusted his religious order to Mary's protection, and he actively promoted the prayer of the rosary while preaching the Catholic Faith throughout Europe and whenever the missionaries would go. The prayer of the rosary is a powerful devotion and well known throughout the world. Even non-Catholics recognize this specific practice as a Catholic form of prayer. The praying of the rosary is not just about reciting specific prayers like our father and hail Mary, but especially it is a prayer that helps us to meditate on the mysteries of Christ life and his work of our redemption. Mary frequently reminded us throughout history of her many visits from heaven to use this prayer and she promised us that much good will be accomplished for ourselves, for others and the world. May our faithfulness to praying the rosary be our expression of our devotion and love for Mary, who leads us always to her divine Son. May the daily recitation of the rosary, be our participation in the School of Mary, who is our model of virtue, holiness, and love of God.

Why is it so important to register with a parish? Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Some people think they automatically are registered just by attending Mass regularly in a particular parish but it requires a form to be submitted to the parish office with copies of sacrament records. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration is also necessary for certain benefits and administrative purposes such as, scheduling sacraments, obtaining a sponsor or godparent eligibility form if requirements are met, a qualification letter from the pastor and receiving a year end donation tax statement. Weekly collection envelopes are used to track attendance at Mass. Registration in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.
