Why is it so important to register with a parish? Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Some people think they automatically are registered just by attending Mass regularly in a particular parish but it requires a form to be submitted to the parish office with copies of sacrament

records. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration is also necessary for certain benefits and administrative purposes such as, scheduling sacraments, obtaining a sponsor or godparent eligibility form if requirements are met, a qualification letter from the pastor and receiving a year end donation tax statement. Weekly collection envelopes are used to track attendance at Mass. Registration in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish. A Letter from Father Marcin

Dear Parish Family,

On this twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we hear Jesus words to the Canaan woman: "O woman great is your faith". Jesus utters these words to a woman who practiced false pagan religion, who herself was in no position to request anything. If Christ granted to her what she asked for, can we begin to imagine what Mary a perfect woman, full of grace, holiness and virtue can obtain for us when she brings our request to her son? Can we imagine how much greater the faith of Mary is, who is completely united with the will of God? If the faith of the pagan woman is praised by Christ, how much more is worthy of praise the faith of Mary a perfected believer. Therefore, it is no surprise that the saints and the Catholic Church would place Mary as praiseworthy example for us to imitate. Mary is the one and only human person whose faith could not be matched by any other. Mary's faith should be our motivation and inspiration for our daily life. She never doubted God or his words. Mary constantly sought to know the will of God and carry it out perfectly with humility and faith. When the Archangel Gabriel announced to her the will of God for her to be the mother of the savior, she only sought to understand how she could accomplish the Lord's will. When Mary was told by Gabriel about her cousin Elizabeth that she was pregnant, Mary immediately decided to make a visit to her cousin. She did not question the words of the Archangel, for she believed that it was all true. When Mary went with Joseph to Bethlehem and there was no room in the inn, she trusted God would take care of her and her child. When she was told by Joseph that the angel spoke to him and that they must leave for Egypt, she did not doubt Joseph's words, but believed and putted all her trust in God's providence. When Mary went with Jesus and Joseph to the Temple in Jerusalem and on the way back realized that Jesus was missing, Mary looked for Christ with full faith and trust that she would find him. However, Mary's motherly love of her son and her full faith in Jesus' mission was not

empty of suffering, for she shared in the sufferings of Jesus her son. Even when Jesus her son was taken away from her to the passion and death on the cross, she remained by His side full of faith and trust in God's plan. When all the disciples after Jesus' death were locked up in fear in the Upper Room, Mary did not doubt the words of her son who foretold his passion, death, and resurrection. Mary, with full faith and complete trust and peace, awaited the resurrection of her son.

Mary's motherly heart was so perfectly united on earth with the heart of Jesus her son that she is also the Mother of the Church, the Mother of all Christians, the Mother of true believers. Let us seek to imitate the faith of Mary and she will help us to grow in a greater faith in God. Therefore, let us turn our prayer to Our Blessed Mother and ask her to intercede for us and obtain for us a grace of greater faith.
