

Father PJ's Letter

Dear Friends in Christ,

A Blessed 4th Sunday of Advent to you all! Though Christmas is just a few short days away, we are still in the Season of Advent, the season of preparation, the season of waiting.

And what a significant find we have in this weekend's Gospel reading. We have the life of St. Joseph to reflect on. First, he had a deep faith and confidence in God—something which we should all pray for. Not having all the evidence and knowledge of the future, St. Joseph decided to do more than the law and custom required at that time. Justice and compassion led him to his decision of abiding in the presence of our Blessed Mother. He was pulled not by what custom and tradition dictated, but what the law of love prescribed in his heart.

The theology and spirituality of Joseph made possible the first Christmas. If Joseph had not cooperated with God, as does the Blessed Mother, the birth of our Lord would have been exceedingly different.

Secondly, (and I will stop being preachy in this letter in view of this wonderful time), Joseph is a man of silence. He did not have any speaking parts in any of the four Gospels. No wonder that the role of Joseph in School Christmas plays is best reserved for those students who are quite simply, quiet. The silence of Joseph made us understand better the life of our Lord. We do not have to speak in order to be understood. Some expressions of human emotions are better left unsaid than spoken. And, some of our intimate communication with God through our prayer are better expressed in meditation and contemplation, rather than vocal and routine prayers.

What a great lesson to learn from Joseph. It is the art of listening in prayer. He was big enough to listen. He was big enough to pray. May his example and inspiration guide us always in our journey to Bethlehem and in our pilgrimage to heaven. Amen.


