Please register as a parishioner

Why is it so important to register with a parish? Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Some people think they automatically are registered just by attending Mass regularly in a particular parish but it requires a form to be submitted to the parish office with copies of

sacrament records. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration is also necessary for certain benefits and administrative purposes such as, scheduling sacraments, obtaining a sponsor or godparent eligibility form if requirements are met, a qualification letter from the pastor and receiving a year end donation tax statement. Weekly collection envelopes are used to track attendance at Mass. Registration in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish. The Sacrament of Marriage

Holy Matrimony is the covenant a man and woman make to one another and to God to work as partners for the rest of their lives. The woman and man marry one another before a witness of the Church and representatives of the community.

You must be actively registered for 6 months to schedule a marriage preparation meeting at least 1 year in advance of the wedding date. Please do not book venue before choosing date with the parish. 

A Letter from Father Sheldon

My dear Parish Family,

Greetings peace and joy to all of you and your loved ones!

One of the most powerful Christmas images I have seen is the picture of the baby Jesus in the manger. I know you might be asking: "What makes it more powerful than other pictures? It is Christmas. We should see pictures of baby Jesus in the manger everywhere." Well let me describe it more. In this painting, the manger is so bright because it has lights focused on it and the shadow it created, on a distant backdrop, is the cross. I guess that tells us where the manger is leading us to.



If you will allow me, this is how I would read the Theological message of that picture: God, born to be with us by becoming human flesh and his flesh, offered as a sacrifice, has given us salvation. In other words, Christmas unites God and man. The Eucharist, makes this unity work for salvation.

The Eucharist, is the same flesh that was born on Christmas day. But here, in the Eucharist, is the completion of the purpose of God becoming flesh.

This year, the Catholic Church in the United States launched the National Eucharistic Revival. This will culminate in 2025. We are given the opportunity to deepen our appreciation of the Eucharist. With all the programs that we will be having in our parish, we will surely be drawn to strengthen our devotion to the Eucharist. We will discover more the power and beauty of the presence of God hidden in the Sacred Host, God made flesh on Christmas.

This Christmas, our celebrations of Joy is because God became man to be with us. And by being with us in the Eucharist He assures us: "You will have life."

May we all be happy and more forgiving this Christmas and all our lives. Let us not be afraid to live and share the Joys of knowing that God is with us.







Las Posadas 2022

The roots of *Las Posadas* stretch deeply into Latin culture. It originated in Spain, but it's been a yearly celebration throughout Mexico for over 400 years. The tradition commemorates Mary and Joseph's difficult journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem in search of a warm place to stay the night. (*Posadas* is Spanish for "lodgings" or "accommodations.")

Mary and Joseph faced the elements of the journey —and indifferent innkeepers that night. Las Posadas is the story of Christmas: It's about pilgrims and a pilgrimage. The story of Christ's birth has been told and retold so many times it could have lost its luster generations ago. But it hasn't—not even close. If anything, in this world of war, famine and natural disasters, holding on to something as simple and as singularly important as the Nativity story is a necessity to our faith.

Thank you to the eighth grade students and the entire student body for once again, telling us the story of Las Posadas reminding us that in very humble surroundings, the Son of God came to us, to bring peace.
