





# OPERATION LIFE PROGRAM FOR VALENTINE'S DAY FEBRUARY 11, 2023

St. Jerome and Friends was created in 1997, when a parent from St. Jerome School, whose neighbor was affiliated with Operation Life, a residence for disabled adults in Long Branch.

Mrs. Monteleone, first brought the youth choir to sing at their Christmas Event. Since the December of 1997, Event, Saint Jerome parents and students have been going to Operation Life from September through June, every month celebrating Holidays and the end of the year. Then several years back we changed to October through May. The only time we have missed celebrating with the residents was from March of 2020 through September 2022.
