


Mission Statement

A Letter from Father Sheldon

Dear Parish Family,

Be proud. Be loud. Jesus is your Savior.

We all have televisions. I believe we notice that television commercials often tend to be louder than the main feature we are watching. It is so loud and intrusive and annoying that many people complained. But thats what commercial advertisement do. Grab attention. One way is to be loud, make an abrupt interruption. Another use of an attractive image that will stick in our minds.



In the gospel this Sunday, John the Baptist was performing his preaching ministry. In a way he was advertising. Jesus appeared. He made an abrupt interruption, and probably his voice got louder when he saw Jesus. "Behold, the Lamb of God" In other words: "Look there is the Lamb of God!". It may be likened to a television commercial. But this was not just a commercial ad. John the Baptist was proclaiming the truth. The Messiah was there. Present and real. And True.

John was performing his Role and mission. He was pointing the people to Jesus. He had to get the attention of people not to himself but to the Real Messiah, "whose sandals strap he was not even worthy to untie."

Part of our Christian duty is to point others to Jesus. We must be a walking advertisement for Jesus. We don't need to be loud preachers. But our actions speak louder that Jesus is our Lord and Savior.

The 50th Annual National March for Life is scheduled for Friday, January 20, 2023 in Washington, DC. Please save the date.

Our Lady of Hope is partnering with St. Michael's Parish and with Christ the King Parish (Star of the Sea and Holy Trinity) on a three-parish bus collaboration. The bus will be departing from the St. Jerome's parking lot at approximately 6:45 a.m. following a 6:00 a.m. Mass in the St. Jerome's Church. The fee for the bus is \$10.00 per passenger. Cash or check payable to St. Michael's Church may be mailed to the St. Jerome's parish office or dropped-off at the St. Jerome's parish office. The deadline is Monday, January 16 for reserving a seat on the bus by phoning or emailing Kathryn Perez. Seating on the bus is very limited (maximum of 24 passengers) so it is important to sign-up for a seat as soon as possible. The bus will return to the St. Jerome's parking lot at approximately 9:30 p.m. on Friday night.

Students may travel on the bus at no charge. Teenagers and children under 18 years of age accompanied by a parent may travel on the bus at no charge.


