

Father PJ's Letter

Dear Friends in Christ,

Not this Sunday, but next Sunday, **January 26th** is THE "Sunday of the Word of God, as declared by Pope Francis. In order to promote a closer relationship with holy Scripture and its dissemination in the world, our Holy Father wrote in his apostolic letter last September 30th that this "yearlong day devoted to the Bible should not be seen as a yearly event but, rather, a yearlong event, for we urgently need to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures and of the Risen Lord."



This is a very timely reminder for us, considering that one of our two places of worship is named after St. Jerome. Our school also carries his name. It is also to be noted that Pope Francis's letter was published on the 1,600th anniversary of St. Jerome's death and his feast day.

"The Bible," he noted, "cannot be just the heritage of some, much less a collection of books for the benefit of a privileged few. It belongs above all to those called to hear its message and to recognize themselves in its words. Furthermore, "the Bible is the book of the Lord's people, who, in listening to it, move from dispersion and division towards unity. The word of God unites believers and makes them one people," he stated.

St. Jerome was once quoted as saying that "ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ." He also said, "Begin now to be what you will be hereafter." Friends, may we begin this year right by reading more, studying more and living well the words in the Sacred Book.


