

#### A Letter from Father Sheldon

I hope you are all having a wonderful summer.

We all know last summer was not a good one because of COVID lockdowns. We all stayed at home. This summer, thankfully, is becoming more normal. Many cities and states are open now. Restrictions are down. That means, many are going on a trip as summer is a season for travelling. "Travel light" can be a byword this time of year.



"Travel light" was also the advice given by Jesus to his apostles. They were sent on their mission to spread the Gospel. Jesus told them not to bring too many gadgets- just a walking stick. No Food; No credit cards, no cellphones. WHAT? Perhaps Jesus wanted them to trust in God's providence. Maybe the good news they bear was sufficient to give them the means to find food. How? The good news they preach will whisper into people's hearts and be generous to them. I guess that's what happened. Remember, in the Acts of the Apostles (4:34-35) we are told: "because those who owned lands or houses would sell their property, bring the proceeds from the sales, and lay them at the apostles' feet for distribution to anyone as he had need."

The word "Apostle" literally means one who is sent. It comes from the Greek word: "Apostolos". In the new Testament, it includes being a witness to Jesus' life death and resurrection. By the grace of the Sacrament of Baptism, we become apostles. Through our life in the Sacraments we witness the mysteries of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus so that we will be sent to spread the Gospel by the lives we lead.

I know it's impossible now a days to travel without cellphones, tablets, laptops, extra shoes for the gym. We cannot avoid sometimes to pay for checked luggage. But whenever we travel, one thing we should not leave behind is the word of God in our hearts. We are the apostles of our time, not just in church but, from the real meaning of the word apostle—to be on the road with the word of the Lord. And if we avoid too many distractions in life, I believe our travels will be much lighter.
