

A Letter from Father Sheldon

My dear fellow Christians,

Greetings of peace!

The other day, Charlie jokingly said to me: "Hey father, this time I do the spiritual, you do the physical." Its funny because I know what he meant. He sees that my duty is mainly taking care of the spiritual needs of our parishioners, while he makes sure our lawns are trimmed.

However, I will say, both the spiritual and the physical are important in our church life. We need to have a well maintained worship site, inside and outside. The physical surroundings of the church, garden and grotto, the decorative walls and stained glass windows, all enhance our prayer mood. That means both, the seen and unseen, work together to direct our hearts and minds to God. It is still God's presence we aim to experience in the physical elements we see and feel.

The same thing we can say with our christian works. The fruits of our prayers are corporeal works. We pray so that we will have the strength to do good deeds. Our physical actions then, must always speak of the living word of God in our hearts. The contemplative and active life are like "zeros and ones" in our system. We function better if both are present.

That is the point of the Gospel this Sunday. Here we are told about Martha and Mary. They are sisters who are friends of Jesus. Jesus was a guest in their house. (Other disciples might have been there also. So Martha had to prepare a meal for more than one guest) Martha could have been panicking in the kitchen. She saw her sister at the feet of Jesus, listening to Him. Martha complained that it is not right that her sister is not helping her prepare their meal. But Jesus told her Mary did the right thing. And it should not be taken away from her.

Listening to the word of God and doing the work for God-both must be found in the life of a Christian disciple.

Next Weekend we will honor the grandparents and the elderly. We thank them for sharing with us their faith.




