

A Letter from Father Marcin

Dear Parish Family,

This past week we celebrated our fifth Anniversary of our parish of Our Lady of Hope. This small marking gives us the opportunity to pause and reflect on the past years and offer our thanks to God for the many blessings we all have received during this period. Five years is not a long time, but only through passage of time, we can see the good done and shortcomings that are room for growth and improvement. Our parish joined two wonderful parishes into a union. Each of the parishes brought their uniqueness and distinctiveness to form a new family. The analogy of marriage is certainly a very fitting one here. Two distinct individuals are joined together to form a one unite, a one bond, a one family. This experience is an opportunity for us to grow in appreciation of our Catholic Faith and our Catholic Church. Although there are many different parishes, dioceses, regions and nations we are all one Catholic Church united in one Faith and in one Lord. Of course, we have boundaries, markings, geographical locations, but those things are there only to help us with organization, to have a certain structure. All these structures are only an instrument that help us in our missionary work of salvation that Christ entrusted to His Church. The missionary work of salvation has one ultimate goal, the salvation of souls, to lead souls to Christ. If we remember the goal of our mission then we will be able to see our parish, our lives in right context. Sometimes we can see our Catholic Church, our Catholic Faith though a narrow view of particular parish or place and that is understandable since this is what we are familiar with, our normal regular experience. However, the Catholic Church is so much more, for just as there is a physical component, there is also a spiritual one. When we profess our Catholic Faith in reciting of the Creed: "I believe in One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church" we recall this reality. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the prayer of the entire Church. During Holy Communion, we enter into union with Christ and His Body the Church. During the Holy Mass, we are praying for the Church not just here on earth, but also in purgatory when we offer prayers for the faithful departed. During the Holy Mass, we also unite our prayer to the prayer of the saints that are members of the Catholic Church already in heaven. Therefore as we are aware of differences we seek to emphasize what unites us what makes us one, for there is strength in unity. Therefore, let us pray through the intercession of Our Blessed Mother, Our Lady of Hope that we may grow in greater Faith, Hope and Love of Our Lord Jesus Christ and His One Holy Catholic and Apostolic Church.
