Free transportation to the Mass and Rally for Life

Saturday, June 24, 2023 @ St. Mary of the Assumption in Trenton

The Cathedral of St. Mary of the Assumption in Trenton has announced that there will be a 9:30 AM Mass for Life on Saturday, June 24, 2023 just prior to NJ Right to Life's 11:00 AM Rally for Life. This day will mark the first anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's *Dobbs vs Jackson* decision that overruled the *Roe vs Wade* decision. The Mass for Life will conclude in plenty of time for Mass-goers to walk to the Rally for Life at the NJ Statehouse Annex, which is about four tenths of a mile from the Cathedral and about a 10-minute walk.

St. Michael's Church (800 Ocean Avenue, Long Branch, NJ 07740) is sponsoring a chartered school bus to take up to 53 individuals to the Mass for Life and the Rally for Life. **ALL (parishioners and non-parishioners alike) are welcome** to travel with us on this bus to these important events. Registration for a seat on the bus will be on a first come, first served basis. There will be **no charge for the passengers** who ride on this bus, however, we will gladly and gratefully accept a free will donation to help the parish cover the expenses of the bus and the bus driver's gratuity. Rest rooms will be available at the Cathedral in the church hall in the basement. There will be no rest room on our chartered school bus. Please feel free to bring your own "brown bag lunch" and snacks and bottled water etc. Do not bring signs and banners; they will be provided at the Rally. A Letter from Father Marcín

Dear Parish Family

The Month of June is the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Unlike the world, that celebrates sin that cries out to heaven for vengeance, we turn to Our Blessed Lord and His loving heart. The devotion to the Sacred Heart originated from the private revelations of Jesus Christ to French nun St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. Jesus appeared to her and revealed to her that His heart burns with love for humanity, yet His heart receives coldness and indifferentism. This loving heart of Jesus that was pierced for our offenses, continues to suffer for the sins that people continue to commit. Jesus complained to St. Margaret that so few seek to love His heart and to make an acts of reparations for the sins that wound His heart. Jesus said to her that He seeks those souls that would be willing to console His heart with acts of love and to do the acts of reparation on behalf of sinners. His loving heart has already suffered so much and would want to pour out His love into our hearts, but no one comes to ask of Him for this love. Jesus desires that we turn to His loving heart so that we may find in it the refugee from dangers, comfort in suffering and mercy for sinners especially those with a harden heart. Jesus promised that those who promote this devotion would receive many graces for themselves and others. On Friday, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus to offer our adoration and thanks to God for loving us sinners with such a great love. We also begged Our Lord Jesus Christ for grace of mercy for ourselves for the time that we offended Him and plead for mercy on behalf of others who are lost that they may experience conversion of heart and turn to God for His mercy. This devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus was widely known throughout the Church, however many Catholics today either are not aware of it because no one told them about it, or the fervor for this devotion has diminished. It is crucial for our families and ourselves that we renew this devotion in our daily lives. The first thing that each family should do is to obtain and display the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (it should be blessed) in a prominent place. Secondly, each family should make an act of consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus to entrust and dedicate their family to the Sacred Heart. An act of consecration is important because through it we voluntarily surrender and submit ourselves to the loving will of Christ, which is to love Him and to love what He loves and desire what He desires. We should daily offer a short prayer or invocation to the Sacred Heart, which can be found in prayer books or online. Since we seek to grow in love of Jesus and to share His loving concern for our loved ones who may have drifted away from the faith or are in danger of losing their salvation let us turn to Christ's Sacred Heart. In Jesus's heart, we will find all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge for the life of true Christian holiness and virtue. Therefore let us pray to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, O Most Sacred Heart of Jesus have mercy on us! Jesus meek and humble of heart make our hearts like unto thine!




