

Dear Friends in Christ,

Greetings of Peace and Love!

We are a people of hope. And so, amidst this Corona Virus crisis, allow me to center on hope, and the good things we can all do.

<u>Prayers of Hope</u>. Since Tuesday last week, we have been live streaming our Daily Mass @ 9AM and Rosary. You can join us in prayer through our Facebook Account Our Lady of Hope Parish or through our parish website ladyofhopeparish.org.

You can also lead either the 10 A.M. or 11 A.M. Rosary during the livestream Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from your home. Let me know beforehand so that I can give you your assigned date and time, and tell you the specifics.

- <u>Pictures, Plots and Places of Hope</u>. I have also been taking notes on my journal daily. Some have received it through Flocknote, others through my personal Facebook Account. All of us have our own stories to tell during this pandemic crisis. The details, if told and written, may unfold in the future. But, the stories we now write and share can bring us hope, and connect us more with each other.
- If you have any story of hope to share (100 words or less maybe), do send it to me so that we can feature it in our page. And not just stories, if you have pictures of places, or of people that give you hope during these times, do send it.
- <u>Pieces and Periods of Hope</u>. A week before I learned that our public Masses will be suspended, I received an envelope from one of our parishioners containing her contribution for Easter Flowers. There is hope! Easter is coming.

Thank you to those who continually drop off their weekly parish envelopes, and those who sent them through postal mail. We need your financial support in sustaining our parish and our school.

This is also one of those fine moments to register with Online Giving. Only a few of our families are on it for now.

<u>People of Hope</u>. I received emails and offers of help from our fellow parishioners.

- One is as follows: "If we know of anyone in the parish who needs assistance, or food, or sanitary supplies, or just a phone call to say hi, let us know. We can all work to help each other the best we can."
- Another offer of help: "I would be happy to make calls and do some shopping...would love to call and check" on some members of our parish family.

- It is now Day 7 in my Journal. Some excerpts from it: "Jesus Christ is our greatest hope. He will never give us a burden that we can never carry. He knows us even before this virus began."


