The Sacrament of Marriage

Holy Matrimony is the covenant a man and woman make to one another and to God to work as partners for the rest of their lives. The woman and man marry one another before a witness of the Church and representatives of the community.

Are you prepared, as you follow the path of Marriage, to love and honor each other for as long as you both shall live?

You must be actively registered for 6 months to schedule a marriage preparation meeting at least 1 year in advance of the wedding date. Please do not book venue before choosing date with the parish. Please register as a parishioner

Why is it so important to register with a parish? Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Some people think they automatically are registered just by attending Mass regularly in a particular parish but it requires a form to be submitted to the parish office with copies of sacrament records. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration is also necessary for certain benefits and administrative purposes such as, scheduling sacraments, obtaining a sponsor or godparent eligibility form if requirements are met, a qualification letter from the pastor and receiving a year end donation tax statement. Weekly collection envelopes are used to track attendance at Mass. Registration in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish. A Letter from Father Marcin

Dear Parish Family,

The 13th of May is a particularly important day for us Catholics. In 1917 on that day, Our Blessed Mother appeared in Fatima to three children Jacinta, Francesco and Lucia. She delivered a message to the children that humanity sins greatly offend God and that many souls are falling into Hell because no one is praying for them or making any sacrifices for their conversion. She urged them to pray the rosary daily and to make acts of reparation to God for the sins against Her Immaculate Heart. She also asked them to pray for conversion of sinners and for the peace in the world. She warned that if humanity will not change, God would send great chastisement upon the world through a great war. Because of that, many innocent people will suffer along with the Catholic Church. During one of the apparitions in consecutive months, she also showed them the vision of Hell so that they would see with their own eyes this sad reality. Although she revealed to them much troubling news, she also offered them hope that at the end, Her Immaculate Heart would triumph and the peace will be granted to the world for a time. The authenticity of this apparition and its message was confirmed by the miracle of the sun that took place in October 13, 1917 witnessed by over 70,000 people. The message of Fatima is still current and urgent of our attention. On another Sunday in May I will share with you more details regarding Mary's request to us and the request that God has made through her. Our Lady of Fatima, Pray for us!

This weekend we also honor our earthly mothers in a special way to acknowledge and give thanks to them for their love, dedication and kindness. We seek to show our appreciation for the tireless service in care for our families and our lives. We just could not do without them. They are our inspiration to live our lives with greater care for others and not to count the cost, but to love selflessly. They teach us to be hospitable and generous. The Lord calls us to honor our mothers every day, but we take this opportunity once a year to remember what a great gift they are to us. Although we pray for our mothers every day, today we raise our thanks and praise to God for bestowing on us such a blessing. Dear Moms, we love you and thank you. We pray may God richly bless you with good health, joy and peace, today and every day. Happy Mother's Day!

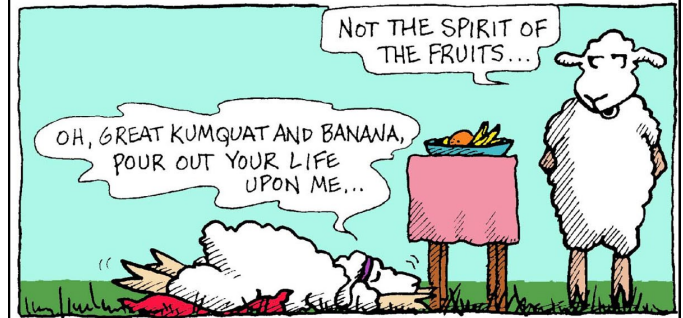
