

Father PJ's Letter

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace and Joy to you and your loved ones!



I have not seen most of you for the past two months or so. But, I know you are there. You are present in our livestream Masses, Rosaries and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, in your support of our parish, and in our thoughts and prayers. There is no other sign of being a faith family community than being related and connected spiritually in these trying times.

Amid all these pandemic crises, centering on our Lord Jesus as our God and Savior is our primary focus. He did not come on earth to explain away suffering. He did not remove suffering as part of our human condition. He came to fill it with his presence.

The Gospel for this weekend is taken from John and recounts the prayer of our Lord at his last meal. In the second part of his prayer, as Jesus faces his passion, he thinks of his disciples (and us). We hear Jesus say that both he and his Father see us as members of their immediate family. They want us to be with them in time to come.

Thus, the last verses of the Gospel point out that the boundaries and separations that define most relationships are entirely lacking within the divine family. Disciples of every age and time have a home in the intimate love of Jesus and his Father. When we ourselves extend and share this love, Jesus is continuously glorified.
