

- ◆ Part Five (Nov. 15) Eucharistic Lexicon including words, terms and expressions describing or referring to Holy Eucharist or its celebration



A Letter from Father Sheldon

My dear Parish Family,

We started the month of November with the celebration of All Saints day. Our church honors our nameless brothers and sisters who died faithful to God. Some of them lived and suffered death in the same manner as Saints we know. But we know they are now with God in heaven. That Feast was followed immediately by All Souls' Day. reminding us that we are still connected to our loved ones who have gone before us into eternal life. This feast helps us think about our own souls on the journey to God. With that the month of November seems to invite us to think about death. Not in a morbid way but in way that it will help us think that death is our entrance to eternal union with God. thinking about death, will help us think about life.



I will always remember the days when I was a boy in the Philippines, when, like every families there even today, my family would visit the cemetery on these two Holy Days. We would hang out there as if it was a picnic because we packed some snacks. Of course we always say some prayers for our beloved dead. But I was more excited about the snacks and seeing friends who were there with their families also. We stayed there for hours until dark. So it was like a "fiesta" in the cemetery but filled with holy remembrance of loved ones and praying together as a family. That is one thing that makes me miss that practice which not all cultures do. However, there may be various differences in celebrating this beautiful and meaningful church tradition, we are all one in believing that our God is "the God of the living", because our loved ones who have died, means only they have gone to eternal life. In the fullness of His presence.

There is plenary indulgence gained in visiting the cemetery and praying for the dead between November 1 and 8. That means those souls who may be in purgatory, through our prayers, can quickly be released and enter into heaven sooner. This can be applied to our loved ones or the poor souls whom no one is praying for.

Why is it so important to register with a parish? Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Some people think they automatically are registered just by attending Mass regularly in a particular parish but it requires a form to be submitted to the parish office with copies of sacrament records. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of your parish. Registration is also necessary for certain benefits and administrative purposes such as, scheduling sacraments, obtaining a sponsor or godparent eligibility form if requirements are met, a qualification letter from the pastor and receiving a year end donation tax statement. Registration in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.
