

A Letter from Father Sheldon

My dear sisters and brothers,

As I write this letter, I am 1 year and two days old as your Pastor. Now that I am trying to recall the first day I moved in, the song by the Lettermen is playing in my head: *"try to remember the kind of September...."*. It was still a quiet September when I came. I can say, only half of the public spaces in the state or the entire country were open. The church was allowed only 30 percent attendance at Mass. No music. Livestreams. Online Masses. Virtual Meetings, etc. After one year, I still need to know many of you, my dear parishioners, as many of you still need to



know me more. Now the song by ABBA is playing: "knowing me, knowing you, Aha.. is the best I can do." I will continue working on it, to know you more.

But I think what is really important is that we know Jesus more. We don't stop getting to know him more and more. "Who do you say the son of man is? "Jesus asked the question to his apostles if they knew Him. They have been together for some time now. I believe Jesus wanted to find out if the disciples knew him who he really is. Not by what they hear from other people. Not by his popularity. Jesus wanted his disciples to know Him from their hearts. That He is their God-Savior.

Let us not just come to Mass because we have to. We come to Mass because we have a personal relationship with Jesus. From our hearts we know He is our Loving Savior. If we have a personal relationship with Him, then people will see that He lives in us and through us.

On Sunday, September 26th, 2021, we will have our Parish Picnic. Our time to get to know one another better. And that through our fellowship: Fun and sharing of food, our friendly relationship with one another reflects our personal relationship with Jesus, God and Savior.

Also try to remember the sad September 11. Pray for the victims and heroes.
