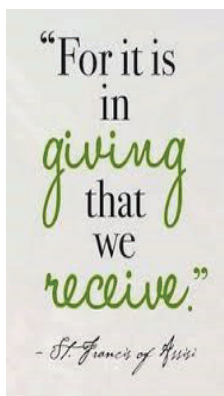

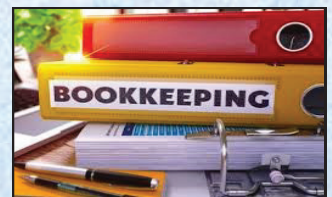

Support Life-Play Bocce!



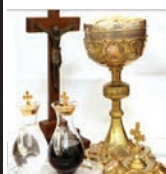

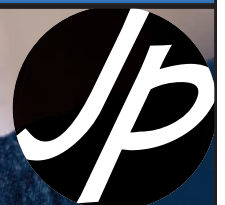
